The Purpose..

- Learn for the Purpose of Making Disciples
- Understand Scripture
- Equip for the Purpose of:
 - Teaching What You Learn
 - Share Life, Not Just Information
- Build Relationships
- Look to Change Yourself (Hebrews 12:1-2)
- Fulfill the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19)

What is a Disciple?

- Disciple refers to Student or Apprentice.
- Becoming a Disciple of Jesus is as simple as obeying His call to follow.
- Being a Disciple of Jesus
 - Imitate Him
 - Carry on His Ministry
 - Become Like Him

How Do I Become a Disciple?

- Jesus' first message- Matthew 4:17
- Repent means 'to turn'.
- All Have Sinned (Romans 3:23)
- The Wages of Sin is Death (Romans 6:23)
- So How are we Saved? (Romans 10:9)
- There is nothing we can do to save ourselves, it was ALL accomplished by Jesus Christ.
- Jesus Christ paid the punishment for our crimes.

The Lord of Grace

- Works Cannot Save (Ephesians 2:8-9)
- Salvation Requires Faith: Do you believe that Jesus is who He says He is?
- What does it mean that Jesus is *Lord*?
 - Master
 - Owner
 - Person in Position of Authority
- If Jesus is Lord, then He Sets the Agenda

It All Comes Down to Love

- Jesus' Commands (Matthew 22:37-40)
 - Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.
 - You shall love your neighbor as yourself.
- Linking Those Commands
 - If you Love Me, Keep My Commandments (John 14:15)
 - If you don't love your neighbor, you don't love Me. (I John 4:20-21)
- Christ's Example (I John 3:16)
 - Love for God and obedience to Jesus Christ cannot be Separated.

Count the Cost

- What it really means to be a follower of Jesus.
- Before we can teach others, we need to examine our own heart and make sure that we are disciples.
- Luke 14:25-33
 - What does this *really* mean?
